Best Practice No. 1

01. Title of the Practice:-

To stick Radium stickers on Road-side Trees.

02. Objectives of the Practice:-

For the said practice following objectives are framed.

- 01. To avoid road accident.
- 02. To travel safe travelling in night.
- 03. Social awareness among the students.

03. The Context:-

The students of the college under the guidance of principal made the planning to stick radium stickers on the roadside trees. For sticking radium the road from Gadchiroli to Chandala village is selected.

04. The Practice:-

Under the guidance of our principal, the students of the college as a social responsibility decided to stick the radium stickers on the roadside trees. The objective of the drive is to avoid road accident at night of the vehicles. For sticking radium stickers on the trees from Gadchiroli to Chandala village was selected. Gadchiroli to Chandala road is very dense forest area and curvy and it is very dangerous to drive at night. So by seeing the need and convenience of the people, the stickers of radium are stuck on the roadside trees. They cover near about 10 Km dense forest road for sticking the radium. By this drive they followed their social responsibility.

05. Evidence of Success:-

This practice is accomplished during the academic year 2020-21, in COVID-19 lead lockdown period by the selective students and the college teachers. The road from Gadchiroli to Chandala village was selected for sticking radium stickers on the roadside trees. The report and documentary proof are kept ready by the NSS department.

06. Problems Encountered and Resource Required:-

It was the COVID-19 lead lockdown period and most of the students were in their home town or own village, so we faced some difficulties to call them to the college, so we called local students for accomplishing this practice. For conducting the drive only 18 students were involved in sticking radium stickers due to lockdown. 10 Km road area from Gadchiroli to Chandala village is covered for sticking radium. Due to low budget and less numbers of students we could cover only 10 Km range of the said road.



Best Practice No. 2

01. Title of the Practice:-

Arrangement of drinking water for the birds on the trees in the college campus.

02. Objectives:-

For the said practice following objectives are framed.

- 01. To make the arrangement of drinking water for the birds in the summer season.
- 02. To protect the birds.
- 03. Conservation of wild life.
- 04. To avoid the migration of the birds.
- 05. To reduce the death rate of birds due to thirst.

03. The Context:-

In summer season birds migrate or die due to thirst, so under the guidance and suggestion of principal, the teachers of the college and selective students decided to make the arrangement of drinking water for the birds on the trees in the college campus.

04. The Practice:-

It is observed that the birds those were living on the trees in the college campus were reducing in the summer season. One of the major reasons for reducing is unavailability of drinking water, so they were migrating or may die due to thirst. The principal and teacher staff decided to make such arrangement on the trees in the college campus for birds, due to which they will live on the trees in summer season. With the help of the selective students, teachers made the arrangement of drinking water for birds at their own places means on the trees in the college campus. Students and teachers tied up and hung the earthen and plastic

pots on the trees in the college campus. The purpose of the practice is to survive birds in summer season and conserve them and avoid them from migration and reduce death rate due to lack of drinking water. Under the supervision our students and in absence of the students watered the pots on the trees.

05. Evidence of Success:-

This practice is done in the academic year 2020-21 on the trees in the college premises with the help of selective students of the college. The college teachers helped and purchased earthen pots, plastic pots and other required things. The report and documentary proofs are kept ready by the NSS department.

06. Problem Encountered and Resource Required:-

There is no such remarkable problem is encountered during accomplishing the practice. We tied only limited pots on the trees, due to insufficient of fund.
